From vision to reality

A milestone for Pelican Marsh

Pelican Marsh and the Pelican Marsh Golf Club have formally executed a written agreement to develop approximately 10 employee parking spaces across the street from the Community Center. Putting this agreement in place marks an important step forward and supports our ongoing long-range planning efforts.

This initiative has been led by the Pelican Marsh Foundation, which will fund the parking improvements. After more than a year of thoughtful discussions, the Foundation and the Golf Club finalized an agreement that positions the community well for future planning.

Securing this parking solution creates the opportunity for a potential more than 3,000 square-foot

expansion of the Community Center — an investment designed to support the evolving needs of our residents.

Preliminary concepts for the expansion include a significantly enlarged fitness center, a dedicated 500-square-foot spin studio, and a versatile

multipurpose room intended to accommodate activities such as games, cards, educational programming, and social gatherings. As with all major community investments, any future expansion would be subject to resident approval and county review, reflecting our shared commitment to thoughtful, responsible planning.

Sunglasses are also valuable since they also protect against the dangers of UV rays. Lastly, proper hydration is also important factor for optimal performance.



Dink & Glow 2026





Consistency beats intensity

Building bone health through regular movement

As we move into spring, many residents feel motivated to train harder or increase workout intensity. While enthusiasm is always positive, the most reliable path to strong bones, improved balance, and long-term longevity is not intensity — it is consistent, repeated movement over time.

Bone tissue responds best to regular mechanical stress. Activities such as resistance training, weight-bearing exercise, balance work, and functional movement signal the body to maintain and strengthen bone. These benefits occur gradually and depend far more on frequency and consistency than on occasional high-intensity workouts.

While Pelican Marsh does not offer classes labeled specifically as “bone health” or “bone builders,” it's important to note that many of our group fitness classes already include the key elements shown to support bone density and skeletal strength. Strength training, bodyweight exercises, balance challenges, functional movements, and controlled impact — all commonly found across our class offerings — are the



same foundational components used in evidence-based bone fitness programs.

Consistency is what allows these benefits to accumulate. Residents who attend classes regularly tend to improve not only strength and endurance, but also postural stability, coordination, and confidence in movement. These qualities are critical for reducing fall risk, protecting bone health, and maintaining independence as we age.

Structured routines also reduce the risk of injury. Gradual progression allows muscles, joints, and connective tissue to adapt safely, making exercise more sustainable over the long term. Sporadic

high-intensity efforts, by contrast, often lead to setbacks that interrupt progress altogether.

Online class registration supports this long-term approach by encouraging planning and commitment. When workouts are scheduled in advance, they are more likely to happen and become part of a lasting routine.

This March, focus less on how hard you work in any single session and more on how often you show up. Consistent participation in Pelican Marsh's diverse fitness offerings provides meaningful benefits for bone health, mobility and longevity without the need for extreme intensity.



Otters in our community

What you should know

How lucky are we? Having otters in the community is a great sign of a healthy ecosystem. Residents may be delighted to spot river otters swimming in lakes, canals, or resting along shorelines in our community. While playful and fascinating to watch, otters are wild animals, and it's important to understand how to coexist with them safely and respectfully.

The otters seen in Southwest Florida are typically North American river otters. They are excellent swimmers, highly intelligent, and very social. Otters feed primarily on fish,



crustaceans, and small aquatic animals and are most active during early morning and evening

hours. Their presence is a positive sign as otters thrive in clean water and healthy habitats.

Otters may look friendly, but they are not pets. Like all wild animals, they can become defensive if they feel threatened, especially if protecting young. Remember to observe quietly from a distance, never attempt to touch, feed, or approach otters and keep pets leashed and away from otters and their dens. Feeding otters or trying to interact with them can cause them to lose their natural fear of humans, which often leads to dangerous situations for both people and wildlife. It can also be illegal to harass or feed wildlife under Florida law.

If an otter appears injured, trapped or behaving aggressively, contact Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) Wildlife Assistance rather than intervening yourself.

Living alongside otters is one of the joys of life in Southwest Florida. By giving them space and respecting their role in the ecosystem, we help ensure these remarkable animals remain safe, wild, and part of our community for years to come.


